<div>Description</div> <div><a href="#">Github PR link</a></div> <p>The test.rb script used by make run etc is explicitly located in the \$srcdir - the location of the Ruby source code.</p> <p>The <a href="#">Building Ruby</a> documentation recommends using out-of-source builds.</p> <p>Requiring test.rb to be located in the source directory prevents me from having multiple build directories, with a distinct test.rb per build, instead forcing pollution of the source directory.</p> <p>I propose looking for test.rb in the current working directory. This will maintain compatibility with in-source builds, and provide extra flexibility for those of us using out-of-source builds.</p> <p>There will be a small one time impact for Ruby committers, who will have to move their existing test.rb files into their build directories.</p>
